AF EFMP Respite Child Care

Provides a temporary rest period and downtime for parents who have children with special needs. Care can be offered at either FCC home or Child Minder. Participants can use hours per month those who meet the following eligibilities:

1. Enrolled in the USAF EFMP
2. EFM child who is up to 18 years old
3. EFM child who has a moderate or severe condition
4. A sibling who is up to 12 years old
5. EFM child resides with the Airman

WHAT IS THE EFMP?

- EFMP is a **mandatory enrollment program** administered by the medical community that works with key community agencies to identify active-duty sponsors who have family members with special educational or/and medical needs.
- One of the goals is **to protect the Federal entitlements and military benefits of family members** as they move around the world with their active-duty sponsors.
- EFMP- Family Support/Medical/Assignments strive to ensure Air Force sponsors are assigned in locations that **support both the accomplishments of the mission and the well-being of families.**

Who is an EFM?

An Exceptional Family Member (EFM) is a family member enrolled in the Defense Enrollment Eligibility Reporting System (DEERS) who has a diagnosed physical, intellectual, or emotional-psychological condition that **requires ongoing specialized medical and/or educational services.**

Examples might include a family member (adult/child) with Diabetes, Cancer, Asthma, Depression, ADHD, Developmental Delay, Individual Education Plan (IEP), or an Individual Family Service Plan (IFSP).

EFMP-Family Support(FS)

Helps families navigate, advocate, and connect through:

- Completes Family Needs Assessments (FNA) and/or Service Plans (SP) when your family identifies a need, is PCSing, or is separating.

EFMP-FS provides:

- Information and referrals
- 1:1 non-clinical consultation
- Education and outreach
- EFMP recreational events
- EFMP monthly newsletter
- Warm hand-offs to your gaining location.

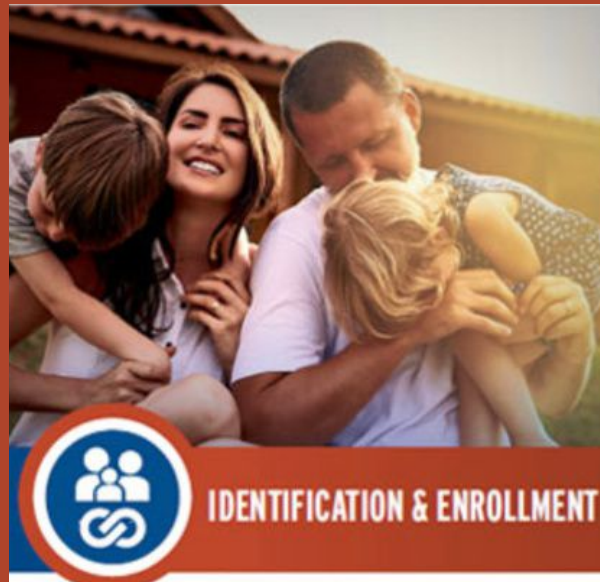

EFMP-Medical (M)

- Enrollment in the EFMP is mandatory for active duty members. Medical services work with families to coordinate identification and enrollment in the EFMP.

- EFMP-M is the contact for when your family is set to PCS to a new location and has to complete the Family member travel screener (FMTS) process.

- EFMP-M handles EFMP reassignments due to a lack of medical and educational services for your family at your current duty location.
