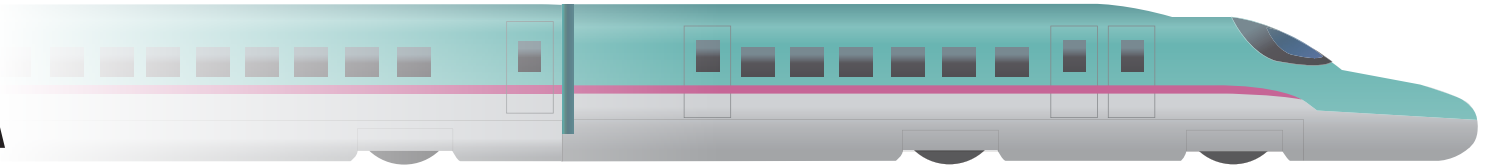

- Half fare for children 6–11 years old. (an adult may take two children under five years old **FREE OF CHARGE** but without a seat).
- Reserved seats can be purchased within one month prior to the departure.
- All JR train and subway lines display station names in both Japanese and alphabet lettering on platform signboards.
- The name of the station is in large letters in the center of the sign; names of adjacent stations appear below or to either side.
- JR fare varies, plus or minus ¥200, due to the seasonal conditions (busy or off-season).
