Do

Practice

Types of Play

- Stroke Play, standard golf play.
- Stableford, point value type of play, Eagles (-2) count as 3 pts, Birdies (-1) 2 pts, Par (E) 1 pt. Person with the most points wins.
- Match Play, Person with the lowest score takes the hole and goes 1 up, Ties no ones gets a point, lose a hole and you go down by 1.
- Scramble, Teams of 2 at least, each team selects the best shot to use, stroke system is in effect
- Best Ball, each team member plays individual ball to finish the hole, lowest score on the team is used for value
