## Training

### GROUND SCHOOL

This course teaches the information needed to pass the FAA knowledge test. The Part 141 course is 35 credit hours. Each student enrolled in the course will receive instruction and tools need to pass, including a Private Pilot Course Kit.

### FLIGHT SCHOOL

Becoming an FAA licensed pilot requires a minimum of 35 hours of flight training:

- 20 hours with an instructor
- 15 hours of solo flight

Most students plan on flying 40-45 hours before becoming proficient.

Training hours are billed per flight.
