



Do you provide propane?

- No. We do provide tanks, hoses, and regulators, but not the propane.
- There are a number of local places you may go a few that we have used are:
 - Pikes Peak Traveland
 - U-Haul
 - Big R
- If you choose to use your own tanks you must ensure that all couplings fit properly and you will be responsible for any damages that arise.



Do you provide personal items such as dishes, linens, ...?

- No. All personal items must be provided by you.
- So popular items people often forget:
 - Toilet Paper
 - Dish Soap
 - Towels
 - Sheets and blankets
 - Can openers
 - Lighter (for stove)
 - Flashlights

Can I take the camper off-road?

- "Off-Road" is defined as travel on rough terrain. Even though some of our campers look like they are built to go off-road, they are not.
- While we do not allow off-road travel, our campers can easily handle dirt roads as long as they are mostly smooth.

 Please use good judgement. Camper towing and repairs can be expensive and will be charged to the customer.

Is smoking allowed in the campers? Are pets allowed in the campers?

- Absolutely no smoking, vaping, or candles inside the campers.
- We love animals here at Outdoor Rec, but some customers are allergic. Please no animals of any kind inside the campers.





What if I get in late and don't have time to clean my camper before I bring it back?

- We are happy to provide you with cleaning products when you come to your turn-in appointment and you may clean it then.
- If you are unable to clean it then, you will be charged a rate of \$35/hr. (It takes us approximately 4-6 hrs. to properly clean the exterior and interior cabin areas of a camper. With the current COVID-19 requirements we anticipate this will take much longer.)





Where can I empty the tanks?

- There is no dump station on Schriever AFB. The closest FREE dump station is on Peterson AFB (see map on next slide).
- It is your responsibility to empty all tanks (Black, Grey, and Fresh Water) and rinse the lines prior to bringing the camper back.
- If the tanks do not read empty you will have an opportunity to take the camper to Peterson AFB and flush the lines again until they are clean.
- If you choose not to re-flush the lines we will assess you a \$150 nonnegotiable flat fee.
