<p>HUMPING LACES</p> <p>Stand with your feet together and arms by your sides. In one motion, jump so that your feet are flat with your toes together and your arms are raised above your head. In the same motion, reverse the movement bringing your feet back to the starting position.</p> <p>It's a slow process, but getting used to it.</p>	<p>HIP BRIDGE</p> <p>Lie on your back with your spine straight on your shoulders and lower back all the way up to the floor. Bring your knees up to the position of your feet and lift the feet on the floor as close to your hips as is comfortable. Keeping your arms and upper body on the floor, raise your hips toward the ceiling, and then lower for a second before lowering the motion and lowering your hips back to the floor.</p> <p>If you can't get inside, you just get outside.</p>
<p>ISIR-UPS</p> <p>Place your hands on the floor under your feet. Begin with your arms over your head and your legs straight out over your "toes" and toes. Lift the feet and hold by bending your knees straight up. In the position of your arms and legs, move the feet to the knees straightening your arms. Move back to your starting position.</p>	<p>FRONT VIEW</p> <p>SIDE VIEW</p> <p>PLANK</p> <p>Place your hands on the floor under your feet, with your arms straight out over your "toes" and toes. Lift the feet and hold by bending your knees straight up. In the position of your arms and legs, move the feet to the knees straightening your arms. Move back to your starting position.</p> <p>SIDE PLANK</p> <p>To do a side plank, hold the same position with your arms and legs on one side of your feet and one forearm.</p>
