The base is bringing RecTrac in as an automated point-of-sales system. It is designed to provide a more streamlined service to patrons of Arts & Crafts, ITT, the PrintShop, Outdoor Recreation, and more. The beauty of RecTrac is that once you complete your first transaction, you create a household, and that household is universal throughout the facilities at Columbus AFB. Also, if you PCS [permanent change of station] out of Columbus AFB and move to another Air Force base that has RecTrac, all of your information is in the system already when dealing with any other base's Force Support Squadron. This system is enhancing customer service worldwide!

Columbus is very excited to get out of the stone age of using registers that have a key to it. 14FSS currently employs a pen-and-paper system. WEATHERIZING YOUR HOME

With the flash of cold weather that just passed and with spring fast approaching, it is a perfect time to review tips on weatherizing your home.

When the temperature drops below freezing, it is well worth your time and effort to implement some simple tasks to prevent chaos from frozen pipes or flooding when pipes burst. The cost for repairs is outrageous and the inconvenience for maintenance to make the repairs is just a complete disruption to our daily lives and routines. Fortunately for everyone, the Hunt Housing Military Community has put together some suggestions on how to prevent pipes from freezing to help us make it through the winter months without catastrophe!

Before the temperature dips to 32 degrees, Hunt Housing strongly encourages everyone to implement the following list:

- 1.) Disconnect garden hoses.** In the winter months, disconnect your garden hose from the outside hose bib, and store until spring. If they are not disconnected, you will risk the water freezing and pipes bursting in your home.
- 2.) Never turn your heat off under any circumstances.** Set your thermostat no lower than 65 degrees. Even if you are planning on going out of town or leaving your home for more than 24 hours, it is imperative to leave the heat running to help prevent your pipes from freezing and bursting.

- 3.) Let your faucets drip.** Open your faucets in the kitchen and bathrooms to allow the cold water to drip. This allows for the water to have a constant flow and assists with preventing pipes from freezing.

- 4.) Keep Your Garage Door Closed.** Keep your garage door completely closed when not in use during the winter months.

- 5.) Open Cabinets.** During extended periods of below freezing temperatures, keep kitchen and bathroom cabinets open so that the warm air can reach pipes along exterior walls that are often exposed to the most extreme temperatures.

- 6.) When leaving for vacation, notify the leasing office if you're going on vacation for an extended length of time.**

- 7.) Leave registers in unused rooms open.** Any registers in unused spare rooms should be left open in order to keep the room warm and prevent interior water lines from freezing.

- 8.) Do NOT warm up your vehicle inside your garage.** This can create high levels of carbon monoxide in your garage and your home.

- 9.) Remove heater obstructions.** As spring arrives in Mississippi, weatherizing your home becomes a crucial task to safeguard against the region's unique climatic challenges. The main order of business is protecting your residence against the unpredictable weather conditions that characterize the season.

Light flooding, often triggered by sporadic rain showers, can be mitigated through proper weatherization measures. Heavy thunderstorms, a common occurrence, pose a threat to the structural integrity of homes, making it essential to reinforce vulnerable areas. Additionally, the high humidity prevalent in the region during spring can lead to mold and mildew growth, affecting both the health of occupants and the longevity of the building.

Here are some steps you can take both on-base and off-base during the wet season.

1) Flood Protection

If you live off base, you can install weather-resistant barriers around entryways such as flood shields and/or light sandbagging. Stay vigilant during heavy storms, and aware of rising water levels. The Giant Voice system will give regular warnings during storm and flood conditions. Contact your housing office for more precautions.

2) Mold and Mildew Prevention

Notify Housing of any gaps or cracks in walls and foundations to minimize moisture infiltration. This is especially crucial in areas prone to humidity, such as basements and attics. You can optionally dehumidifiers to maintain optimal humidity levels within your home.

3) Structural Concerns

Mississippi is known for thunderstorms. Report any concerns about structural issues noticed during storm conditions promptly - like weather-stripping and issues with doors or windows, etc., to address vulnerabilities. The housing office will coordinate necessary repairs.

Whether you live on or off base these recommendations are useful and highly encouraged to avoid property damage and costly repairs during both winter and spring months. If you live on base and experience frozen or burst pipe in winter, or observe any severe structural damage, please call in an emergency work order at (662) 245-8800.

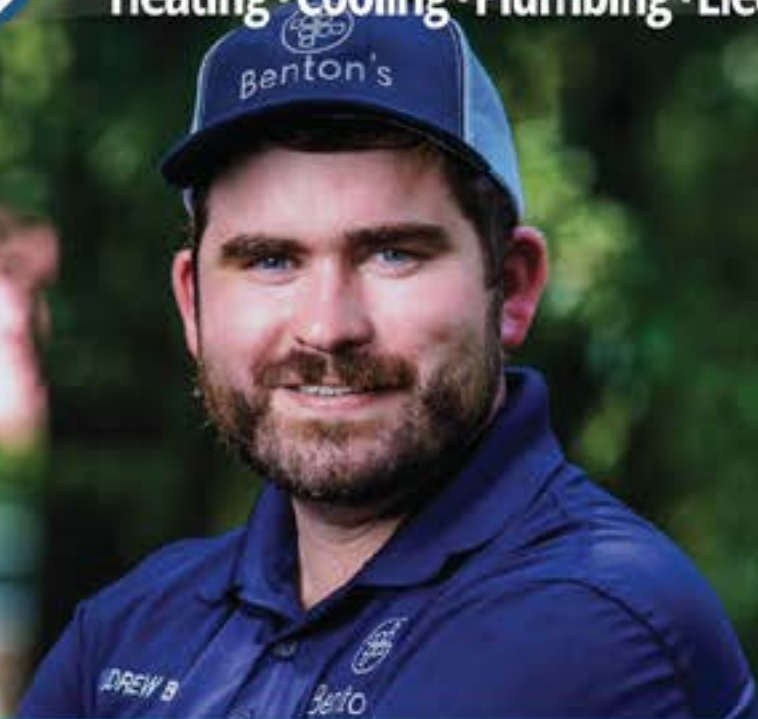

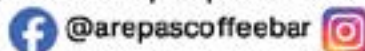
