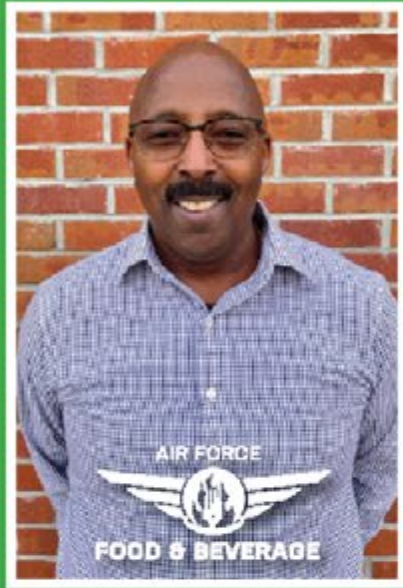

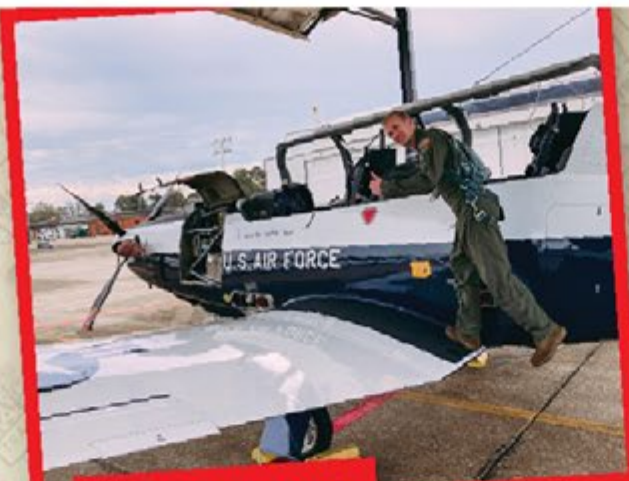

### CONGRESSIONALLY MANDATED TIMELINE:

#### ➤ INITIAL COUNSELING AND PRE-SEPARATION (IC/PS)

No later than 365 days prior to DOS, Must be completed before attending class

#### ➤ TRANSITION ASSISTANCE CURRICULUM | 5-DAY TAP CLASS

Recommended to be completed 12-18 months from DOS

#### ➤ ADDITIONAL 2-DAY TRACK CLASSES EMPLOYMENT, ENTREPRENEURSHIP, EDUCATION, AND VOCATIONAL

Attend any time after TAP and before the capstone.

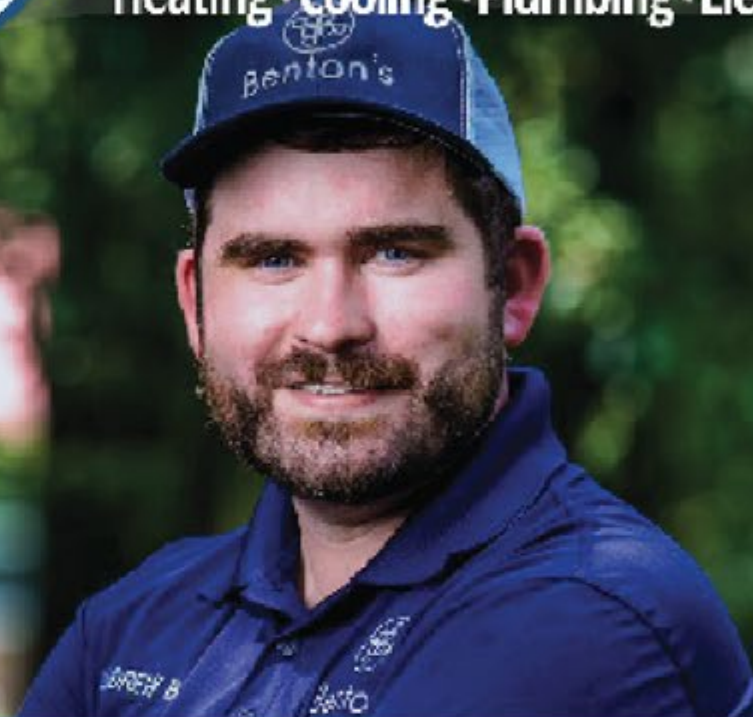
