"Disney ticket sales are now up and running!" according to Lindsay Harrison, ITT manager at Columbus Air Force Base.

Harrison is pleased to be able to offer these amazing deals for military members. As of 26 Sept, Disneyland tickets went live. Now Disney World packages and tickets are available for sale. ITT can now sell the salute packages, and any one to six day park hopper tickets for Disney world.

Salute packages are available to Active Duty, retired military, and their dependents. An ID verification will be conducted by ITT to ensure members qualify. They have 4 and 5 day salute packages, park hoppers - tickets that allow you to hop around parks anytime after 2pm. Park hopper plus includes the water park as well!

Reservations must be made for day based tickets for one park, and you can do a one or two day park hopper so you can reserve two parks to hop around. After 2pm you can go to all parks. The four day salute ticket package is the best deal ITT has to offer! With this package you can hop around to any 4 parks after 2 pm.

Our team will communicate the park's blackout dates, when military salute packages do not apply.

She transferred to The University of Oklahoma (OU) and graduated with a Bachelors of Fine Arts in Dance Performance.

At OU she trained in modern, contemporary, and ballet dance and performed with Contemporary Dance Oklahoma. During her time in college she performed and studied at dance festivals and intensives in Beijing, China, Utah, and Colorado.
