MEMORANDUM FOR ALL DINING FACILITY PATRONS

SUBJECT: Dress Code for Davis-Monthan Dining Facilities

1. In order to maintain a pleasant and sanitary atmosphere, the following dress code applies to everyone who utilizes the Dining Facility and Flight Kitchen.

- a. Military Attire: All authorized uniform combinations IAW AFI 36-2903
- b. Civilian Attire: Clothing must be clean and in good taste, good repair, and consist of a top, bottom, and footwear. Do not mix military and civilian clothing.
- c. Head Gear: Is not authorized with the exception of on-duty emergency responders.

2. The following are NOT authorized for wear in the base dining facilities:

- a. Swimwear
- b. Muddy or heavily soiled shoes or boots
- c. Soiled or sweaty PT and exercise clothing
- d. Short sleeve shirts or tank tops with exposed arm pits
- e. Any attire that is profane, obscene, has racial slurs, or could otherwise bring discredit to the integrity or professionalism of the Air Force will not be allowed.

**Military Members only:**

- f. **Males:** Any form of body piercing
- g. **Females:** Body piercing with the exception of those authorized IAW AFI 36-2903

3. The dining facility will refuse service to all violators of this dress code letter.

4. This letter supersedes all guidance referencing the dress code for Davis-Monthan AFB dining facilities.

5. This letter applies to all personnel per AFI 36-2903, *Dress and Personal Appearance of Air Force Personnel*. Direct questions or concerns to the Food Service Office at 228-1303.
