## Lodging Responsibility

Provide quality lodging facilities and service to authorized personnel facilitating mission readiness and quality of life, while keeping official travel costs to a minimum.

Promptly and professionally solve or address issues or problems as they surface.

## Occupant Responsibility

#### Please Do

Notify Guest Services by dialing "o" from your room telephone to report damage or problems in your room. Any damage beyond wear and tear will be your responsibility. Payment will be in accordance with requirements from the legal office.

Clean up after yourself when using common areas of the building i.e. laundry rooms, BBQ grills, patios and dayrooms. Please dispose of all food and trash in appropriate trash receptacles.

Respect your neighbors.

Leave kitchenette areas clean and orderly. Housekeeping is not required to wash utensils, glassware, dishes, silverware etc.

Keep noise to a minimum.

Report the presence of rodents and insects immediately.

Comply with fire, health and safety regulations.

Be responsible for the conduct of your guests and/or family members while in government lodging. Their actions must not infringe on the rights of others.

Turn off all lights, electronics, etc. while away from the room.

#### Please Don't

Smoke in unauthorized areas. Smoking is strictly prohibited in all lodging facilities. A \$150 DEEP CLEANING FEE WILL BE ACCESSED IF YOU SMOKE IN YOUR ROOM.

Move furniture, equipment or linens from the room.

Tape, thumbtack, staple or nail anything to the walls, doors, cabinets or furnishings in the room.

#### Please Don't (continued)

Attempt repairs of equipment or facilities (you could be held liable for damages)

Leave the room unlocked except during an evacuation for fire, etc.

Drive or park vehicles on grass, walking, or jogging paths

Keep bicycles, auto parts, etc. in your room.

Bring pets into any lodging facility. We love animals, but pets are not authorized in our facilities. If pets are found, owner/occupant will be charged a minimum of \$150 for carpet, furniture cleaning, flea spray, etc. The owner/occupant is also financially responsible for any damages caused by pets. Additionally, it is unlawful to leave your pet in your vehicle. A listing of local boarding facilities is on pag3 8 and a copy is available from the front desk.

Leave the coffee pot plugged into the electrical outlet when not in your room.



#### Fire & Safety

Cooking is not permitted. Your room is equipped with a microwave. This is the only cooking appliance allowed in guest quarters. Use of portable cooking appliances (hot plates, small gas grills, George Foreman grills, etc.) is not permitted and will be referred to the Base Fire Department for action. There are several approved outdoor grills located on the patios at building 401, 801, and 802 for guest use.

Tampering with fire extinguishers, alarms or detectors is prohibited.

The use of candles is prohibited in lodging facilities. Candles found in rooms will be removed and disposed of by the housekeeping staff. Candle wax damage is subject to a \$150 damage assessment.

All rooms are furnished with an automatic coffee maker and you will be furnished with coffee, creamer and sugar daily. Turning the coffee maker on without water will cause it to burn out. Please do not put anything but water in the dispenser as any other type of liquid will damage the unit and you may have to pay for its replacement. If your unit is

inoperable, please fill out a maintenance form and leave it for your housekeeper or report it to the Front Desk.

Personal electrical appliances (i.e. curling irons, heating pads) will be unplugged when not in use.

All electrical appliances (i.e. televisions, radioes, and computers) will be turned off when not in use or when you leave the room.

The storing of flammable liquids is strictly prohibited.

Portable charcoal grills require a burn permit from the fire department (678-655-4840) and are not to be placed with 15 feet of the building and are not authorized under covered areas or porches.

Overloading electrical circuits by the use of multi-plug extension cords is not authorized.

Do not store items on top of lamp shades and please don't hang clothes on the sprinkler heads.

The use of a space heater is not authorized.

All building attic entrances are off limits to everyone except the Base Fire Department & Maintenance workers.

#### Energy Conservation

Dobbins Inn is dedicated to conserving energy. You play an important role in helping us achieve our goals if you:

Turn off all lights, television, radio and your personal electronic devices you brought with you, every time you leave your room or when you are not using them.

Turn the water "ON" and "OFF" when shaving or brushing your teeth instead of letting the water run.

Take an 8 minute shower instead of 10 minutes.

During winter months, please turn your heaters down when not in your room. This will help reduce cost and prevent mold buildup.

Reuse your towel "one more time" and report faucet leaks immediately.

## Alcohol Consumption/Parties



Consumption of alcohol must not cause the person to act in such a way as to disturb the rest and privacy of other guests. Litter and/or residue left from the consumption of alcohol in the inside /outside areas will be cleaned up by the person(s)/group that caused it. Gatherings or parties of considerable size must be approved by the Lodging Manager and will be supervised by a responsible person.

Checks are accepted only for the exact purchase amount. For your convenience, checks may be cashed at the Club by Club members only; Base Exchange; or by one of the banks that are located in the surrounding community. Check cashing privileges are subject to their check cashing policy.

#### Check-in and Check-out Time



Check-in time is 1400 hours, or as soon as the room is clean and available. Please check with the reception desk to see if your room is available for immediate occupancy. Air Force established checkout time is 1100. We wish you didn't have to leave at all! But, if you must, please remember checkout time is 1100. If you require a late checkout, approval must be obtained in advance. Your room will automatically cancel at 1200 on the scheduled checkout date.

## Housekeeping



It is our goal to provide our occupants with the best housekeeping service possible. However, we must have your cooperation. Please ensure that all personal items such as clothing, shoes, dishes, food items, etc. are stored in the closet, drawers, or refrigerator.

Our housekeeping staff is not authorized to move personal belongings and may not be efficiently clean your room if your items are not properly stored. Linen is changed every 7 days and upon check-outs. Please do not move furniture, televisions, refrigerator, etc. as this prevents the housekeeping staff from efficiently and safely cleaning your room. When a "Do Not Disturb" sign is on the door and not removed by 1200, you will receive service the following day. The "Do Not Disturb" sign should only be displayed when the occupant is in their room and wishes to not be disturbed. Please note a member of the lodging staff will not enter a guest room displaying a "Do Not Disturb" sign, unless the sign has been displayed for three consecutive days. On the third day, lodging will enter the room to ensure the safety of the guest and condition of the room.

Services provided daily for STAY OVERS (7 days or less): waste baskets cleaned and emptied, coffee/tea restocked, floors/carpet cleaned if needed, bed made in accordance with establishment AF Inns Standards, towels left on the floor removed and replaced, and bathtub/shower, vanities, sinks, mirrors, and toilets cleaned. Services provided weekly for EXTENDED STAY OVERS (more than 7 days: all "stay over" listed items above plus the sheets changed, light dusting completed, and furniture polished.

Housekeeping hours of operation: Weekdays 0730 -1630 / Weekends and Holidays 0800 - 1545. If any of the above housekeeping services are not provided, please call the Housekeeping Manager from your in room guest phone dial extension 7128 or 7131. You may also dial 678-655-4745, option 3.

## **High Speed Internet**



The in-room HSIA service is wireless with little or no configuration needed depending on your device. You will need to accept the ISP's

Acceptable Use Policy before your device will be allowed to connect to the wireless network. If you already use your computer on a network at home or at your office, you should be able to access our service. If you experience problems connecting to the internet, please call the front desk by dialing "o" from your room phone. NOTE: This service is not intended for downloading games or movies. The downloading of games and movies hogs the bandwidth and prevents other guests from accessing the internet. Your computer should be turned off when you are not in your room.

#### Lost Keys



Should you lose your key, please report to the Front Desk immediately to obtain a new one. If you extend your stay, please stop by the front desk to have your key entry card extended.

#### Maintenance



Lodging and base civil engineering strive to maintain high standards of maintenance in all quarters. Should your TV, clock radio, coffee maker, etc. malfunction or if you have a maintenance issue, please contact the Front Desk by dialing "o" from your room phone. Please note that if you have a maintenance issue and are displaying a "Do Not Disturb" sign, maintenance will not enter your room unless it is an emergency. Please help us help you by not displaying the "Do Not Disturb" sign when you call in a maintenance work request.

#### Messages



All rooms are equipped with telephones that have message lights. If a message has been left on your telephone, please dial 6000 to retrieve your messages. Follow the prompts. Your password is your four digit room number (printed on the phone, room key sleeve, and the door of your room).

## **Parking**



Each of our facilities has a parking area for your use. Please help to keep these areas clean. Vehicle maintenance, changing oil, washing, etc. are not permitted. Large or oversized vehicles may not be parked in spaces marked for normal size vehicles. We recommend using the parking behind each building for large vehicles and those with trailers and RV's. Park these vehicles horizontally to the space markings to avoid blocking deliveries or emergency vehicles.

#### **Postal Mail Services**



Incoming TDY/PCS personnel who expect to receive mail while in Lodging should contact the post office located at Building 727, DSN: 625-5049. The hours of operation are Monday - Thursday 1300 - 1500 and on Friday 0900 - 1100. Closed for lunch and reopens from 1300 -1330 for parcel pick-up and incoming mail. Your mail can be picked up at Lodging, generally one day after it arrives at the base. FedEx and UPS will deliver directly to Lodging. Please ensure your name and/or room number is included in the delivery address. You may pick up your mail/packages at the Lodging Front Desk ,located in Building 800.

#### Payment or Fees



Lodging rates are \$55.00 for shared baths; \$70.00 for private baths; and \$79 for Business Suites. Prices are subject to change without notice. Payments are accepted 24 hours a day, seven days a week. The Dobbins Inn accepts cash, personal checks, traveler checks, Visa, Mastercard, and the AF Services Club Card. Official Duty Travelers (TDY or PCS) are required to use the Government Travel Card to pay for room fees. This mandatory policy applies to military and civilian personnel. Note: All guests will be charged the total room charges up to a long-term stay of 30 days upon check-in. Guests staying longer than 30 days will have their credit card charged on day 31 to cover previous miscellaneous charges and room charges to cover up to another 30 day stay. Cash/check paying guests will pay in advance for the remaining days of occupancy.

#### **Pecuniary Liability**



While you are a guest in our Inn, US Government supplied equipment and fixed assets under your control are your responsibility. If, through negligence or abuse, an item is damaged or destroyed, you will be required to pay for the cost of repair, replacement, or cleaning of that item. If you see anyone abusing or misappropriating government property, contact the Front Desk by dialing "o" from your room phone or dial 678-655-4908. The Security Forces Crime Stoppers number is 678-655-2677.

## Personal Effects & Property



Personal property should be secured in the safe or taken with you when you leave your room. Housekeepers are instructed not to pick up or move a guest's personal property at any time. Leaving items scattered around the room will result in your room not being cleaned thoroughly. For example, if you leave clothing or books on an unmade bed, it will remain unmade. This is to protect your rights and limit the liability of those who clean your room.

## Personalization of Quarters



Occupants may not decorate or personalize their quarters. The furniture in the room has been arranged in the best possible manner. Please do not rearrange furniture since doing so can cause damage or a fire hazard. Walls may not be painted, marked or scarred. Tape and thumbtacks should not be used on walls, doors, or furniture. Pornographic, inflammatory, offensive, or prejudicial materials will not be displayed in guest rooms.

#### Pest Control



If you see any of these unregistered guests, it is not because we do not have an entomology program. It is due to the fact that no chemical has yet been developed that can permanently eradicate these pests without a human risk factor in terms of environmental health. If you see more than your share, call the front desk by dialing "o" from your room phone for special attention. You can help by properly disposing of food items in the waste basket and placing perishable and open food items in the refrigerator.

## **Reception Desk**



Our reception desk is open 24 hours a day. Please contact a staff member, or dial "o" from your room phone if you need assistance.

#### Refunds



If for some reason you check out early and have a refund due, the following procedures will be taken. Payment made by credit card will be refunded to your credit card and payment by personal check will be refunded by cash only if the check has cleared. (Continued on page 19)

#### ROOM TO ROOM Four Digit Room Number

To determine the four digit room number, look for the four digit number that is on the outside of your door, on your room telephone, on your room key card, or call the front desk. Rooms in building 401 begin with 4; building 800 begin with 8, building 801 begin with 1, and building 802 begin with 2. For example, a guest staying in building 401, room 112 may be contacted by dilaing 4112 on the room phone.

To register/change automatic wakeup, dial 73050 & follow the prompts. To cancel automatic wakeup, dial 73050, press 2 to cancel the wakeup call.

To retrieve messages from your phone, press the message button. Your password is your four digit room number.





#### GENERAL OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

#### SETTING AND OPERATING THE ALARM

- Press the Alarm Set Button. The wake time on the display will flash.
- Press the Reverse/Tuning or Forward/Tuning button to set the alarm time.

Hold a tuning button for a few seconds to advance the time quickly.

- For wake to buzzer, press the Enter Button to set the alarm wake time. The unit will beep twice and the Buzzer Alarm On Indicator will appear, showing that the buzzer alarm will sound at the set time.
- 4. For wake to radio, press one of the Radio Preset Buttons then Enter Button to set the alarm wake time. The unit will beep twice and the Radio Alarm On Indicator will appear, showing that the radio alarm will sound at the set time.
- When the alarm sounds, press the Snooze/Dimmer Bar for a 9-minute Snooze time, or press the Alarm On/Off Button to shut of the alarm.
   The Alarm Off Indicator will appear.

NOTE: Pressing the Alarm On/Off Button while alarm is sounding turns off alarm. The Alarm On/Off Button also selects alarm mode.

#### PLAYING THE RADIO

- There are two ways to turn on the radio. Radio Preset Buttons to listen to one of the preset stations, or press the Power On/Off Button. The radio frequency will appear on the display.
- 2. Set the AM or FM band by pushing the Radio Band Button.
- Press either the Reverse/Tuning or Forward/Tuning Button to find the station. Hold a tuning button for a few seconds to scan the dial quickly.
- 4. Rotate Volume Control to adjust volume level.
- Press Power On/Off Button to shut of the radio.

NOTE: Extend the wire antenna for better FM reception. Keep Fluorescent lamps away from the unit as they may cause interference with radio.

#### PLAYING THE MP3/AUX LINE-IN

- Connect your CD/MP3 Player or other device to the MP3/Aux Line Plug.
- 2. Press the MP-3/Aux Line-in Button. "AU" will appear on the display.
- 3. Turn the Volume Control to adjust the volume level.

NOTE: To avoid distortion of sound, always set the volume level of the auxiliary device to middle position, and adjust the desired volume level from the radio.

4. Press the Power On/Off Button to shut off unit. Remember to turn off your audio device.

#### Overview

Dobbins Air Reserve Base in Marietta, Georgia is a multi-service installation located 16 miles northwest of downtown Atlanta. Dobbins is one of only nine standalone Reserve bases in the Air Force Reserve.

The installation is home to the 94th Airlift Wing, 22nd Air Force Headquarters, Lockheed Martin Plant 6, Georgia National Guard Headquarters, Navy Operational Support Center Atlanta and units of the Army Reserve, Marine Reserve and Civil Air Patrol. The 94th Airlift Wing is the installation host and operational flying unit with eight C-130H3 Hercules aircraft, and more than 2,000 Air Force Reserve and civilian personnel.

#### Operational Mission

- Airmen and units of the 94th AW are currently deployed to locations in Southwest Asia.
   From October 2016 to October 2017, the 94th AW will deploy more than 450 personnel.
- The 94th AW contributes to Rapid Global Mobility through cargo and personnel airlift and tactical airdrop capabilities, provides critical patient care through aeromedical evacuation, and Agile Combat Support through security, logistics, communications, civil engineering and other support functions.
- The 94th AW maintains combat-ready aircrews and aircraft capable of deploying in response to worldwide contingencies and emergencies. The wing is equipped with eight C-

#### **Dobbins Air Reserve Base**

#### Mission

Dobbins Air Reserve Base in Marietta, Ga., is the largest multi-service reserve training base in the work miles northwest of Atlanta, Dobbins ARB supports more than 10,000 guardsmen and reservists from the Army, Navy and Marines. The base is home to the 94th Airlift Wing, which is the host unit, and tenant or including the 22nd Air Force headquarters, Naval Air Station Atlanta and the Georgia Army National Guaircraft are assigned to different flying units at Dobbins and the base including the C-130 Hercules, DC-C-12 Beachcraft Kingair, C-560 Cessna Citation, FA-18 Hornet, E-2 Hawkeye, AH-1 Cobra, UH-1 Huey Blackhawk. The base boasts more than 7,000 take-offs and landings monthly.

#### Personnel

The population consists of nearly 2,500 Air Force reservists and civilians assigned to the 94th AW and 2 combined. More than 2,000 Navy, Marine Corps and Army reservists are also stationed at the base.

#### Organization

Organizations at Dobbins include the 94th Airlift Wing, 22nd Air Force headquarters, Naval Air Station A Georgia Army National Guard.

As the host unit at Dobbins, the 94th AW has a three-fold mission. Its primary mission is to train C-130 I aircrews for the U.S. Air Force - active duty, guard and reserve components. It also maintains combat-redeploy on short notice to support operations around the world. Finally the wing is responsible for providicivil engineering, fire protection, air traffic control and other services to the base and its tenant units. The provides maintenance for the airfield, which is used by NAS and Lockheed Martin/Air Force Plant #6, what adjacent to the base.

Headquarters, 22nd Air Force, is one of three numbered air forces in Air Force Reserve Command. 22n responsible for recruiting and training reservists and for maintaining subordinate units at the highest lew readiness. A by-product of training is to coordinate daily support of the active duty air force. 22nd AF's v mission is to provide combat-ready airlift and support units and augments personnel requirements to Air Command in the United States. More than 27,000 reservists fall under the 22nd Air Force across 14 diff 19 different states.

Naval Air Station Atlanta supports some 2,000 Navy and Marine Corps reservists in 31 different units. F Support Squadron 46 (VR-46) flies the DC-9 Sky Train to support the Chief of Naval Operations airlift m Carrier Airborne Early Warning Squadron 77 (VAW-77) flies the E-2C Hawkeye in support of the nations drug forces in the war on illegal drugs. In addition, the C-12 Beachcraft Kingair transports personnel and throughout the continental U.S. and Caribbean regions.

Marine Air Group 42 (MAG-42) staff headquarters is located aboard NAS Atlanta. The Marines have two located on the base. Marine Helicopter Light Attack Squadron 773 (HMLA-773) flies the AH-1W Cobra a Huey helicopters and has made two deployments to Afghanistan since September 11, 2001. Marine Fig Squadron 142 (VMFA-142) flies the FA-18 Hornet. VMFA-142's mission is to plan for the conduct of air support of the Fleet Marine Force, supervise and train selected Marine Corps Reserve units, and ensure readiness.

#### **FACT SHEET**

The Georgia Army National Guard flies the UH-60 Blackhawk helicopters. Other Army units on the base include the Joint Operations Directorate, which provides counter drug support to civil authorities and operations planning.

Lockheed Martin/Air Force Plant #6, which is adjacent to the base, also shares the Dobbins runway. The corporation uses a 74-acre building to build the C-130 Hercules and the P-3 Orion. Lockheed built the C-141 Starlifter and the C-5B at that plant as well. Lockheed is currently producing the Air Force's F-22 Raptor, an advanced air-to-air fighter designed to replace the F-15 Eagle.

#### **BRAC 2005**

In its 2005 BRAC Recommendations, DoD recommended to close Naval Air Station Atlanta, Ga. As a result, DoD recommended to consolidate the Naval Air Reserve Atlanta, located at NAS Atlanta, with the Navy and Marine Corps Reserve Center forming the newly named Naval Operational Support Center Atlanta (NOSC) located at Dobbins Air Reserve Base. The recommendation also directed NAS Atlanta aviation assets be transferred to aviation bases in Texas, Louisiana, and Georgia which would result in increased maintenance efficiencies and operational synergies.

#### History

Dobbins ARB was built in 1943 and was originally called Marietta Army Airfield. In 1950, the named changed to Dobbins Air Force Base to honor Capt. Charles Dobbins, a pilot from Marietta. Captain Dobbins was killed during World War II when his C-47 aircraft was shot down over the Mediterranean Sea. In June 1992, the name was changed to Dobbins Air Reserve Base.
