The Dover AFB Child Development Center offers the following services for children age 6 weeks – 5 Years who have not started Kindergarten:

Full Day/Weekly Child Care

Fees are based on the Total Family Income

Hourly Child Care

Offered to support short-term child care needs on the installation.

Give Parents A Break (GPAB) - 1st Sat of each month 10 AM – 2 PM

Sponsored by the Air Force Aid Society - GPAB provides child care for eligible parents who are subject to unique stresses due to the nature of military life including deployments, remote tours of duty, and extended working hours. Certificates for GPAB can be obtained from your First Sergeant or the Airman and Family Readiness Center – 302-677-6930. This program is free to eligible families.

School Age Care Program (SAC)



SAC promotes the cognitive, social, emotional, cultural, language, and physical development of children through programs and services that recognize differences in children and youth and encourages self-confidence, curiosity, creativity, self-discipline, and resiliency.

The DAFB School Age Care Program offers the following services for children age 5 (in Kindergarten) – to age 12:

The Youth Center follows the Caesar Rodney School District Calendar Year

Full Day/Weekly Child Care - Offered during school closures, in-service days, school holidays and summer vacation.

Hourly Child Care

Offered to support short-term child care needs on the installation.

Before/After School Care

Provides care "Before" school starts and "After" school ends. Transportation to and from the on base schools is provided.
