

## Hill AFB Child Care Options Guide

### On Base Care:

To receive care on Hill AFB you will need to set up a user profile with [militarychildcare.com](http://militarychildcare.com). [MilitaryChildCare.com](http://MilitaryChildCare.com) (MCC) is a DoD website for eligible Military and DoD families seeking childcare. This website allows you to apply to the Child Development Centers (CDCs), Family Child Care (FCC) homes, and School Age Care (SAC) programs on Hill AFB. As a parent you will need to be responsible for keeping your needs and profile up to date.

- **Child Development Center (CDC):** Provides care for children ages birth -5 years, who are not yet attending kindergarten. There are two centers on CDC East 801-777-6321 and CDC West 801-777-6223.
- **Youth Programs:** Provides care for School Age Children. School Aged Program providing before and after school care and recreation opportunities including Open Rec for children over the age of and a variety of seasonal sports leagues. 801-777-2419
- **Family Child Care (FCC):** FCC licensed/affiliated providers are made up of providers that operate independent businesses both on and around Hill AFB. Hourly and part-time care is available by contacting the providers directly. Rates will vary. Anyone living on base that watches children for more than 10 hours per week from their home is required to be an FCC licensed/affiliated provider. We recommend that you DO NOT set up recurring or fulltime care with anyone living on base that is not an FCC licensed/affiliated provider as you risk your care being cut off and the caregiver can lose his/her base housing privileges. 801-777-0695.

**Subsidy:** Families utilizing care on base may qualify for AF Subsidy which centralizes fees across all childcare programs within the AF. For more information, please contact the Child & Youth Program Flight Chief at 801-777-3599.

### Expanded Child Care:

Expanded Child Care are programs available for Active Duty, National Guard, Reserve members and their families assigned to Hill Air Force Base looking for care assistance. The office of Family Childcare provides information, resources, and assists in the process of requesting the care. All care will require an application, copy of orders, and approval from AFSVC. Once approved the FCC Office will give you information for participating FCC Providers. Each provider will need an AF 1181s for each child provided by the FCC provider, along with current immunizations, including current flu shot.

### Types of Expanded Child Care:

- **PCS Care:** Families PCS-ing *to and from* Hill AFB qualify for 20 hours of free childcare. Bring a copy your PCS orders to the Military & Family Readiness Center (Bldg. 150) front desk and ask for a PCS voucher. Each family is only eligible for one voucher.
- **Deployment Child Care:** Provides up to 16 hours of care per child for children ages 12 and under. This care is available for 30 days prior to a member's deployment of more than 30 days and 16 hours of care for EACH month during the deployment.
- **Returning Home Care:** Provides up to 16 hours of care per child childcare for children ages 12 and under, is available to those Active Duty, National Guard, and Reserve members assigned to Hill Air Force Base after a member's deployment of more than 30 days. Care must be used within 60 days of return.

*Hill AFB CYP does not give official endorsement to programs, organizations, or service providers*

- **Home Community Care:** Provides childcare for children ages 12 and under for single or dual Reservists during monthly drill weekend. Care will only be given when no other adult is available to provide care. Requires AFSVC approval.
- **EFMP Respite Care:** AF EFMP Respite Care Program offers families with children on EFMP, that meet eligibility, 40 hours of respite per month for the child with special needs AND their siblings! Respite time can be used to take a nap, go shopping, or have dinner with your spouse or however you choose to relax. ### **For Off Base Care and Preschools**

**Child Care Aware of America/Military Child Care in Your Neighborhood** is for families who are unable to utilize on-installation childcare options may qualify for fee assistance when using off-installation childcare. 1. Select Help for Military/DoD Families.
2. Select your Branch of Service to learn about the Program
3. For US Air Force Families, create a Profile on [MilitaryChildCare.com](https://militarychildcare.com)
4. In MilitaryChildCare.com, make Requests for Care & Fee Assistance by clicking ‘Military Child Care in Your Neighborhood’ (MCCYN)
5. If you are extended an offer for community child care fee assistance, it will be issued through MilitaryChildCare.com. The offer email will provide instructions on how to accept the space, as well as a link to the Child Care Aware fee assistance enrollment portal
6. After you have created an account in the enrollment portal, you must then complete the electronic fee assistance application, upload the applicable supporting family eligibility documents listed on [www.childcareaware.org](https://www.childcareaware.org), and submit your application through the portal.

**Care About Child Care** is program ran by Children’s Services Society of Utah that can connect families looking for care from both in-home and public childcare centers through out the state of Utah, along with other educational support. **Hill AFB Babysitters Group 2.0 UPDATED AND SECURED** is a closed Facebook page that you request to join. Parents post for a date night or for a last-minute appointment and people offer to care for their kids, and care may be in their home or your home. Members live in many areas both on and around the base, which may help you find someone who resides near you. Be sure you feel comfortable with anyone you plan to leave your child and know the providers may not be licensed and/or background checked. Remember if you are trying to book someone living on base for recurring or fulltime care, they will need to be an FCC licensed/affiliated provider through the base.
