Korean Traditional Brewery & Starfield Anseong Mall

DMZ 3rd Tunnel & Dora Observatory

Explore the Korean Demilitarized Zone (DMZ), including Imjingak Park, where there are many statues and monuments regarding the Korean War; 3rd Infiltration Tunnel, which is one of four known tunnels under the border between North Korea and South Korea; and Dora Observatory, where you can see the North Korean territory through binoculars from the 304 square feet.



Yonggwolsan Sky Road & Byeongpung Falls

Yonggwolsan Mountain stands at 646 meters high and features a "Sky Road" for those feeling adventurous. The sky road is a wide wooden plank path with safety rails and offers stunning views of the Seomjingang River.



Boseong Green Tea Plantation & Folk Village

Boseong is a region where 40% of nation's tea is produced. The large green tea farms sprawls in zigzags across high mountain slopes are picturesque landscapes! Naganeupseong Folk Village is an UNESCO world heritage site, established in late 10th century where the Confucian ideology of living in harmony with nature presides.
