LIBRARY PATRON CARDS

With a valid ID, patrons may receive a library card. All patrons must clear their library account when they out-process or move from Laughlin. The following people may apply for a library card:

- Active duty military personnel and their family members, including Reserves and National Guard.
- Civilian personnel employed at Laughlin AFB and their family members.
- Retired military personnel and their family members.
- Long term-contractors, more than 90 days.
- Non-Laughlin students taking courses on base, with evidence of enrollment.

- Book Club held monthly (last Thursday of the month).

CHILDREN'S BOOKS: Easy Readers for preschool through second grade; Juvenile for grades three through six; and Young Adult Fiction for grades seven and above.

CDs: Music categories include Classical, Country, Jazz, Movies and Shows, Band Music, Pop, Rock & Soul, Religious, International, and Holiday.

eBOOKS, DIGITAL AUDIO BOOKS AND MAGAZINES:
