Holds & Renewals

Once logged in, items can be renewed and materials can be placed on hold. You will be notified when your hold is ready to be picked up. The preferred method of notification is by text.

General Library Information

- Military ID cardholders can register.
- Military ID must be shown in order to check out library materials.
- Services include: internet computers, af.mil computers, Wi-Fi, fax, scanner, copier (limit of 15 pages), and KwikBoost charging station.
- 3 Study Rooms for use - ask at the circulation desk about reservations.
- Printers are connected to all computers (limit of 15 pages).

Checkout limits per account

All items check out for 21 days

- Books—no limit
- Audiobooks—no limit
- Wonderbooks/Vox books/IR books—no limit
- DVDs — Limit 10—includes; DVDs, TV series, Binge Boxes and Documentaries
- Children's DVDs (in the children's room) —limit 10
- Blu-rays—limit 10
- Videogames—limit 2 per system
- Launchpads—limit 2
