Glendale Climate

With zero snowfall and only around nine inches of rain a year, the region is rarely wet. The hottest month of the year is July with an average temperature hovering over 100 degrees, and the coldest month of the year is December with the standard climate at around 40 degrees. The fall and spring seasons are fair, giving residents a chance to get quite comfortable in-between the hotter and colder seasons.

Ft. Tuthill in Flagstaff AZ (2hr drive) is located in the world's largest Ponderosa Pine Forest at the base of the San Francisco Peaks. Our proximity to Grand Canyon National Park, the stunning red rock cliffs of Sedona, and the ancient cliff dwellings at Walnut Canyon make us a popular destination for military personnel.

The Ocean and Disneyland, Legoland, Sea World is just the next state over in California a short 5.5 hr drive.
