COURSE

South Course: Will be closed from 10-12 June for aeration of greens.

North Course: Starting 24 June through mid-October, the North course will have 6 temporary greens while we work on the green's renovation project for holes # 2, 5, 8, 13, 16 and 18. During that time the putting area will also undergo repairs.

Course conditions: Sadly, we continue to fight the lack of rain. We have the luxury of having reclaimed water at our disposal. The North Course has an unlimited supply since the pond over the fence on the left side of #1 South is the reservoir for the North Course. However, the South's water comes from the pond to the right of #1 South fairway. The pond is gravity fed from the reservoir. At this time the water level is being depleting quicker than it's being replenished. The watering schedule is from 7 pm to 7 am. Bill is also hand watering some of the greens on the South to keep the hot spots under control. The best way to describe what is happening to the golf course throughout the day is to imagine a hair dryer on high, blowing hot air for 12 hours.

Will become effective 1 June. Expect an additional discount beginning 24 June for the North course, coinciding with the temporary greens.

As a reminder, we do not issue rain checks unless we close the course. It's Florida, and we will get some type of rain showers throughout the day in the summer (we hope).
