Family members can call Tricare directly and ask for a Tricare Care Manager OR your family member's PCM Team (even off base providers, they have access) can place a referral to request a Tricare Care Manager. They can manage for both Medical and Mental Health reasons, and whether you have Prime or Select.

## Tricare Care Management referrals may be appropriate for the reasons below:

- Anxiety Education/Disease management
- Asthma Education/Disease Management
- Beneficiaries with insufficient supports causing significant impairment or stress
- Beneficiaries with support or resource needs who are unable to navigate system
- Beneficiary failure to follow through with PCM recommendation for mental health treatment
- Beneficiary transfer requiring coordination
- Burn injury requiring a burn unit
- CAD (Coronary Artery Disease) Education/Disease Management
- Catastrophic illness or injury, amputation, multiple trauma
- CHF (Congestive Heart Failure) Education/Disease Management
- Chronic condition resulting in high resource consumption (e.g. hemophilia, Gautier's disease)
- Chronic suicidal, lethal, dangerous behaviors
- Congressional or high profile case
- COPD (Chronic Obstructive Pulmonary Disease) Education/Disease Management
- Diabetes Education/Disease Management
- Dual Behavioral Health diagnosis clients with 2 or more relapses or hospitalizations in one year
- Eating disorder patient has exhausted her yearly benefit
- ECHO other than behavioral health diagnoses
- High utilization of services, including multiple providers without coordination of care
- History of discharge against medical advice with no discharge plan
- Hourly Nursing more than 4 hrs/day
- Humana at Home for MTF Discharge
- Hypertension Education/Disease Management

- Major Depressive Disorder (Depression) Education/Disease Management
- Medical & mental health co-morbidity needing facilitation of communication between providers
- New quadriplegic or paraplegic
- Newly diagnosed patients requiring assistance with education about their illness and resources
- Planned Long Term Acute Care (LTAC) admission
- Post-Traumatic Stress Disorder in ADSM
- Post-Traumatic Stress Disorder in non-ADSM
- Pregnancy with significant identified risks
- Premature Infant, ventilator dependent >24 hours and/or weight less than 1500 grams
- Referral to Residential Treatment Centers (RTC) has been denied
- Repeated non-compliance with recommended treatment resulting in higher levels of care
- Transfers requiring case manager assistance with coordination
- Transplantation Evaluation or procedure (Solid organ or bone marrow/peripheral stem cell)
- Traumatic Brain Injury, Spinal Cord Injuries, stroke, blindness
- Unplanned admissions to acute hospital 3 times or more within 90 days with same diagnosis
- Unstable beneficiary with multiple providers and high dollar utilization requirements
- Ventilator dependent beneficiary
