## WHO WE ARE

The 366th Mountain Home AFB Honor Guard is composed entirely of Enlisted and Commissioned active duty Air Force members from all units assigned or associated with the 366th Fighter Wing.

## WHAT WE DO

The 366th Mountain Home AFB Honor Guard's primary mission is to provide military funeral honors to Active Duty, Retirees, and Veterans in our area of responsibility. We may also support the ceremonial requests from the 366th Fighter Wing and the surrounding communities. These ceremonies involve change of commands, retirements, distinguished visitor visits, luncheons, banquets, parades, and opening ceremonies for business conferences.

## BENEFITS

As a member of the Honor Guard program you will become a part of an Elite Unit, you will receive your Ceremonial uniform, you get to keep your Base Honor Guard Badge upon completion of contract, considered for an Air Force Achievement Medal and have the opportunity to compete for Honor Guard Quarterly/Annual Awards.

## HOW TO JOIN THE TEAM

Steps to take in order to become a member of the 366th Mountain Home AFB Honor Guard are simple, but demanding.

**Eligibility-** Any and all good-standing Airmen, Enlisted or Officer, assigned to Mountain Home AFB to include Tenant units.

**Application-** Fill out an application and have it signed by your supervisor, First Sergeant, and Commander. Submit your application to the Honor Guard NCOIC or Flight Chief.

**Commitment-** Once you have joined the Honor Guard team, it is a one year commitment with a monthly based rotation to serve with the 366th Mountain Home AFB Honor Guard.

**Qualification-** Complete a two week qualification sequence covering different aspects of military bearing and performance is given prior to officially becoming a member of this Elite Base Honor Guard Team.

**Equipment Issue-** Following the completion of all the application procedures you will be issued an Honor Guard uniform and associated equipment.

## OTHER INFORMATION

As a member of the 366th Mountain Home AFB Honor Guard, you will be issued one custom tailored set of the current U.S. Air Force ceremonial uniform, and you will receive training from the most experienced members of the team.
