Youth Center Sponsorship Program

Matches youth ages 9-18 coming to Mountain Home AFB with volunteer sponsors their own age. This will enable them to become familiar with the base and the surrounding area. We also work with children departing Mountain Home AFB for other bases. If you are leaving Mountain Home, we make every effort to contact your receiving base and connect you with a sponsor there. Below is information on becoming a sponsor and requesting sponsorship.

What does a youth sponsor do?

Helps other youth by providing them with information they will like to know about Mountain Home AFB and the surrounding community. It is a fun, exciting and rewarding program that helps youth transition from here to there! Being a youth sponsor will provide the youth with a less stressful and challenging move. The most important part of being a Youth Sponsor is to be a friend and to make them feel welcome at their new community.

How do I become a Youth Sponsor?

To become a youth sponsor fill out the Youth/Teen Sponsor Profile and mail, bring, or email it back to the Youth Center. When a youth request sponsorship we will match you up according to your age and interests.

How do I request for a sponsor?

Fill out and mail or bring in the Mountain Home Youth Sponsorship Request form, to the Youth Center. After we have your request, we will match you up with one of our sponsors who will be around the same age and share the same interests, or we will forward your request to the receiving base. Forms can be found at the Youth Center (bldg. 2830), on the Youth Center page located at www.mhafbfun.com, or at the Military and Family Readiness Center (bldg. 180). Information about the Youth Sponsorship Program will be included in sponsorship package sent to incoming families and during relocation briefings. Youth Programs will collaborate with the AFRC to ensure a connection is made with incoming and outgoing families.
