

100% Disabled American Veteran (DAV) Checklist

Veteran's Required Documents:

- **VA Benefits Summary Letter** - stating 100% rating, permanent & total, and date of award (Sample letter attached)
-OR-
VA Commissary and Exchange Privilege Letter - stating 100% rating, permanent & total, and no further examination are required or date of next exam (Sample letter attached)
- **DD Form 214** - stating Honorable discharge
- **Two forms of unexpired ID** - Driver's License, passport, voter's registration card, SSN card, concealed carry license, etc. (One MUST be a photo ID)

Spouse's Required Documents:

- **Marriage License/Certificate** - Original or certified copy
- **Birth Certificate** - Original or certified copy
- **Social Security Card**
- **Two forms of unexpired ID** - Driver's License, passport, voter's registration card, SSN card, concealed carry license, etc. (One MUST be a photo ID)
- **DD Form 1172-2** - if sponsor is not present (digitally or wet signed by sponsor; wet signatures must be notarized)
