<u>COMPLIANCE WITH LAWS AND REGULATIONS</u>: Students, family members, or guests shall comply with all laws, ordinances, and regulations adopted or established by federal, state, or local government entities and the Rules and Regulations of the Ramstein Aquatic Center.

<u>PARENTAL SUPERVISION</u>: There is no supervision available before or after the swim lesson. Children participating in swim lessons MUST have a parent or legal guardian in the facility during the ENTIRE lesson. Parents not following supervision policy will have their child removed from the swim session without refund or a rescheduled class.

SWIMMING BEFORE AND AFTER LESSONS:

All students who are not current pass holders of the Aquatic Center wishing to swim before or after lessons MUST pay the pool entrance fee. This also applies to all other family members wishing to swim at any time.

REFUNDS, MAKE-UPS, OR TRANSFER POLICY: Please <u>carefully consider</u> your schedule and your child's swimming ability/skill level before choosing the date and time for lessons.

<u>Refunds</u> are only approved for PCS moves (orders required for verification), or illness with a doctor's note. If your child misses group swim lessons for any other reasons, refunds will NOT be given.

<u>Make-up Classes:</u> In the case of a temporary pool closure (i.e. building maintenance, weather, etc) classes will be supplemented with dry land instruction. Make-ups will be provided only if participants are not allowed to enter water for 3 or more class sessions. Make-ups are not guaranteed to be scheduled during the same time as your original lesson.

Transferring your child to a different class is subject to availability with management approval.

SWIM LESSON RULES:

Please read the Health and Safety Rules

Swim diapers (swimmies) are required for children who are not potty-trained.

Prior to class, have your child shower thoroughly and use the restroom.

Make sure your child has his/her hair tied back and out of their face.

Please have swim lesson participants ready to go 5 minutes prior to class so instructors may start class on time.

Do not enter the pool water until directed by the instructor.

Never hold onto other swimmers while in the water.

Parents are asked to observe lessons from ½ pool length away or in the snack bar area.

Please make sure siblings are properly monitored and are not a distraction to other participants during lessons.

Do not bring food or beverages other than water onto the pool deck. This includes gum and candy.

No running allowed at any time.

Remove band aids and jewelry.

No strollers or items with wheels are allowed on the pool deck.
