Snakes on Scott AFB

If you see a snake in the Scott Lake Recreation Area, please keep your distance. Illinois has many different species of snake that are native to the area, both venomous and non-venomous.

If the snake appears non-aggressive, leave it alone and keep children and pets away from the area.

If the snake is in a populated area, is aggressive, or is identified as a venomous species, contact CE (256-2202) for removal. Monitor the location of the snake from a safe distance until CE arrives.



Fishing Rules

- A current base fishing permit is required to fish in the Scott Lakes.
 Permit must be present when fishing.
 An Illinois state fishing license is not required to fish the Scott Lakes.
- Fishing is allowed from the bank, docks, and non-motorized watercraft only. Fishing is only allowed during daylight hours (dawn to dusk).
- Only fishing poles and hand lines and permitted, no seine, spears, bows, or troutlines. Only one pole per person (all individuals with poles must be listed on fishing permit). Bait must either be synthetic, worms, or crickets; no other live bait allowed.
- Ice fishing is not allowed.


Fish Limits

The lake is stocked with the following: catfish, bluegill, carp, crappie, and bass.

- Catfish are limited to 5/day.
- There is no limit on carp, crappie, and bluegill.
- All bass must be returned to the lake.

Scott Lake Recreation Area

- No swimming or wading in the lakes or walking on solid ice on the lakes.
- No discharge of firearms, air, or CO₂ powered guns or bows are allowed within the Scott Lake Recreation Area.
- Only non-motorized boats are allowed on the Scott Lakes.
- Coast Guard approved Life jackets (PFD's) must be worn at all times while on the lakes.
- Do not approach or feed any wildlife.
- Drones are not allowed to be flown in the Scott Lake Recreation Area.
- Pavilion usage is limited to reservation only.
- Picnic areas beside the front lake are available on a first come, first serve basis only. Do not leave any trash or debris at the picnic areas.
- Parking is located at the FamCamp Bathhouse.



Archery Range Rules

Archery Range is located East of Outdoor Recreation on East Dr near the Combat Arms Training Classroom.

- Archers must be fully within the bounds of the archery range when firing. DO NOT STAND ACROSS THE ROAD AND FIRE INTO THE ARCHERY RANGE.
- Range use is only allowed during daylight hours (dawn to dusk).
 Permitted bows include long, recurve or compound, no crossbows allowed.
- Broadheads are not allowed on range targets.
- No discharge of firearms, air, or CO2 powered guns or bows are allowed.
- All archers must fire from the same line; no crossing shots, roving or clout.
- No firing allowed when others are down range.
- When collecting arrows down range, always leave your bow at the shooting line.
- Archers under 18 must be supervised by an adult.
- No alcoholic beverages
- Personal equipment must be inspected by the individual and maintained for safe operation.
- No fighting or horseplay allowed.
- Please pick up trash and debris.

Any violations of these rules could result in range closure.
