- RESTRICTED Reporting confidential, does not trigger an investigation or command involvement; option to convert to unrestricted reporting at any time
- 24/7 "On-Call" agencies: Chaplain, Command Post, EAP, Military Crisis Line, Military One Source, Nurse Advice Line, SARC office
- Military One Source offers special child counselors to work w/ dependents < 18 y.o.
