Whiteman Library Overview

Library Cards

Library cards are available for all active duty, retirees, dependents, and DoD civilians with base access ID cards. To sign up for a library card, you will need to complete a registration form and show valid ID. Families may share a single library account.

Online Resources

Patrons with library accounts have access to 80+ online resources. Resources include streaming services for books and music, language learning platforms, homeschool resources, and test prep material. Visit our website or ask a librarian for more information on how to access these materials.

Late, Lost, or Damaged

Patrons are responsible for all items loaned from the library. Overdue notices will be sent via email and long overdues will be reported to leadership. Lost or damaged materials must be replaced with an exact copy.

Returns and Renewals

Library materials may be renewed twice. Renewals can be done online, over the phone, or in person. Overdue items and Inter-library Loans cannot be renewed. Returns can be completed in the library or in our drop-box located in our parking lot.

Computer Access

Our public computers have CAC readers, but are unable to access NIPR, encrypted materials, or share drive materials. Print services are provided at no cost and are limited to a maximum of 10 pages per day. Library cards are not required to use our computers. WIFI is offered throughout the library.
